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UNLOCKING A LOCKING A SUSTAINABILITY ACHIEVEMENT

In 2017, Tradex Foods developed a system to track every single pound of seafood produced in our SINBAD Brands and Private Label production in order to thoroughly assess the integrity of our sustainability policies.

In this process, we also applied a sustainability outlook algorithm that projected that our Sustainability Rating Score would be **99.58%** by the end of 2020.

We are proud to announce that Tradex Foods has officially achieved an exceptional Sustainability Rating Score of 100% for all SINBAD Branded and Private Label seafood production throughout 2020.

This means that **100%** of all raw materials used in the production of our SINBAD Brands (SINBAD, SINBAD Gold, and SINBAD Platinum), and all Private Label seafood production in 2020 used raw materials harvested from sustainable fisheries.

YEAR-OVER-YEAR IMPROVEMENTS

Since 2017 we have been able to improve our Sustainability Rating Score from 89% at the end of 2018 to **100%** at the end of 2020.

Individually, we scored 100% sustainability across all SINBAD Branded production and 100% for all Private Label production for 2020, compared to 97.25% and 99.34% in 2019; and 85% and 95% in 2018 respectively, for our SINBAD Brands and Private Label production.

100% SUSTAINABILITY

For all SINBAD Brands production we scored 100% sustainable for Atlantic Cod, Chum Salmon, Haddock, Pacific Cod, Pacific Halibut, Pink Salmon, Pink Shrimp, Pollock, Rock Sole, and Tilapia.

For all Private Label production we scored 100% sustainable for Atlantic Cod, Chum Salmon, Flathead Sole, Haddock, Pacific Cod, Pink Salmon, Pollock, and Yellowfin Sole.

METHODOLOGY

TRADEX FOODS USES GUIDANCE FROM THE MARINE STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL, SEAFOOD WATCH, OCEAN WISE, AND FISHCHOICE TO DETERMINE THE SUSTAINABILITY STATUS OF RAW MATERIALS. EVERY SINGLE POUND OF SEAFOOD WE PRODUCE IS ACCOUNTED FOR AND MEASURED AGAINST THEIR SUSTAINABILITY RATINGS, AND THEN ENTERED INTO OUR INFINITE™ SUSTAINABILITY PRODUCTION TRACKER TO PRODUCE A SCORE OUT OF 100%.











OUR HIGHEST MSC CERTIFIED PRODUCTION EVER

In order for seafood to be MSC certified, the MSC Chain of Custody needs to be carried forward all the way through from the fishing grounds to its final destination in food service or retail. This means the vessel harvesting the fish needs to be MSC certified, as well as the fishing area. Then, the raw material needs to be purchased as MSC by an MSC certified processor in order to carry through the MSC Chain of Custody.

If an MSC certified processor does not purchase the raw materials as MSC (even though the raw materials were MSC), then the MSC Chain of Custody breaks and the product can no longer move forward as MSC. If the MSC Chain of Custody is carried forward by the processor, then the product is able to move around the market as an MSC Certified product.

97% of raw materials used were MSC Certified, up from 85% in 2019.

100% used MSC Certified raw materials, up from 94% in 2019.







SUSTAINABLE PRODUCTION BY BRANDS

100% of all SINBAD Brands production in 2020 used raw materials from **sustainable fisheries** resulting in both our SINBAD Gold and SINBAD Platinum brands achieving **100%** for MSC Certified raw materials used. 2020 was a banner year for improving our percentage of MSC Certified production by brand with a robust improvement over 2019.





SINBAD

SINBAD used 100% sustainable raw materials; of that, 91%* of the raw materials were MSC - up from 79% in 2019.

* MSC Certification does not apply to farmed seafood and as our farmed production is also included in this calculation - that is the contributing factor as to why SINBAD brand scored 91% for MSC Certified raw materials used.





SINBAD GOLD

SINBAD Gold used 100% sustainable raw materials; of that, 100% of the raw materials were MSC - up from 99% in 2019.






SINBAD PLATINUM

SINBAD Platinum used 100% sustainable raw materials; of that, 100% of the raw materials were MSC - up from 51% in 2019.





SUSTAINABLE PRODUCTION BY AREA

For our SINBAD Brands production, 65% of raw materials used were harvested in Russia, 34% from the USA, and 1% from Norway. 97% of raw materials used out of Russia were MSC Certified carrying forward the MSC Chain of Custody while all other countries were 100%.

For our Private Label production, 46% of raw materials used were harvested in Russia, and 43% from the USA. 100% of raw materials used out of Russia and the USA were MSC Certified carrying forward the MSC Chain of Custody.


2021 will also mark the year that we launch the newest addition to the SINBAD line of products - introducing **SINBAD Platinum ULTRA**.
